**CUSTOMS MANAGEMENT (SUFFERANCE WHARF)  
(FREEPORT CONTAINER PORT) NOTICE**

(SECTION 6(2))

Citation.

**1.** This Notice may be cited as the Customs Management (Sufferance Wharf) (Freeport Container Port) Notice.

Sufferance wharf.

**2.** The place specified in the Schedule is appointed a sufferance wharf for the lading and unloading of goods by sufferance.

**SCHEDULE**

LANDS COMPRISING 154.57 ACRES SITUATE AT THE WESTERN BANK OF HAWKSBILL CREEK IN THE “PORT AREA” OF FREEPORT, ON THE ISLAND OF GRAND BAHAMA

**ALL THAT** certain lot, piece or parcel of land containing by admeasurement **ONE HUNDRED AND FIFTY-FOUR AND FIFTY-SEVEN HUNDREDS OF AN ACRE** (154.57) or thereabouts being the lot of land shown on a plan recorded in the Lands and Surveys Department of the Grand Bahama Port Authority Limited as Plan No: 1737 situate one (1) mile west of the causeway across Hawksbill Creek.

**ABUTTING AND BOUNDING** towards the **WEST** on lands owned by **BAHAMA CEMENT COMPANY**, towards the **SOUTH** by Freeport Harbour towards the **EAST** partly by Hawksbill Creek and partly by lands owned by Freeport Harbour Company Limited, and towards the **NORTH** by the Fifty (50) ft. wide Queen’s Highway or however else the same may abut and bound which said lot, piece or parcel of land is more particularly delineated and shown coloured pink on the plan of the area.
