The Public Service Commission has approved the advertisement outlined below. It should be brought to the attention of all officers and posted on a notice board until after the closing date for receipt of applications.

VACANCY FOR THE RECRUITMENT OF TRAINEE CUSTOMS/REVENUE OFFICERS- BAHAMAS
CUSTOMS DEPARTMENT (MINISTRY OF FINANCE)

Applications are invited from suitably qualified Bahamians to fill the vacancy that exists for the post of **Trainee Customs/Revenue Officer, Scale U13**, for the Customs Department, Ministry of Finance.

Requirements for the Post Trainee Customs/Revenue Officer:

- Applicants must possess a minimum of two (2) BGCSE subjects or equivalent at grade 'C' or above, one of which must be English Language and the other preferably in Mathematics. However, should the applicant not possess Mathematics at BGCSE level, or equivalent, they must have Mathematics or Arithmetic at BJC level.
- Applicants must be between the ages of 18 and 30 years.

Successful candidates will be required to:

- Undergo and successfully complete a training programme;
- Serve in Bimini, Abaco, Exuma and Eleuthera, in addition to New Providence and Grand Bahama.
- Be employed as a shift workers and, as such, work standard hours on Weekends, Weekdays and Public Holidays.
- Be vetted by the Royal Bahamas Police Force.

Persons who are unwilling to work on these terms need not apply.

The salary of the post is in **Scale U13, \$18,000.00 (fixed salary)**

Serving officers should apply through their Heads of Departments.
