1 Time Range & Fee Structure Adjustments

The following changes were made concerning foreign pleasure vessels when clearing into The Bahamas.

30 DAY CRUISING PERMITS

30 Feet & Under

\$150.00

Exceeding 30-50 Feet

\$250.00

Exceeding 50-100 Feet

\$350.00

Exceeding 100 Feet

\$600.00

No Return Visits Included

6 MONTH CRUISING PERMITS

50 Feet & Under

\$300.00

Exceeding 50-100 Feet

\$750.00

Exceeding 100 Feet

\$2,000.00

One (1) Free Return Visit within the duration of a valid permit.

12 MONTH CRUISING PERMITS

50 Feet & Under

\$500.00

Exceeding 50-100 Feet

\$1,000.00

Exceeding 100 Feet

\$3,000.00

Two (2) Free Return Visits within the duration of a valid permit.

NOTE: Anchorage is **ONLY APPLICABLE** when a foreign pleasure vessel is **NOT MOORING** at a Marina.



2 Anchorage Fees

- Anchorage fees apply to all foreign pleasure vessels entering The Bahamas, with the exception of those mooring at a marina.
- This fee is payable once for the duration of the cruising permit, whether it is 30 days, 6 months, or 12 months. Once the cruising permit expires, payment is required again upon reapplication.

ANCHORAGE FEE STRUCTURE

Vessels on 30 Day Cruising Permits

- Not Exceeding 50 Feet | **\$50.00**
- Exceeding 50 - 100 Feet | **\$100.00**
- Exceeding 100 Feet | **\$200.00**

Vessels on 6 Month Cruising Permits

- Not Exceeding 50 Feet | **\$150.00**
- Exceeding 50 - 100 Feet | **\$350.00**
- Exceeding 100 Feet | **\$1,000.00**

Vessels on 12 Month Cruising Permits

- Not Exceeding 50 Feet | **\$200.00**
- Exceeding 50 - 100 Feet | **\$350.00**
- Exceeding 100 Feet | **\$1,500.00**

Frequent Digital Cruising Card

What is the Frequent Digital Cruising Card?

- The **FDCC** is essentially a Cruising Permit tier that permits you to enter and exit The Bahamas as often as you wish within a span of two years. (Digital card issued on approval)
- It is **important to note** that you still need to utilize Click2Clear to **submit an Inbound Declaration upon your arrival each time** as a check-in. (A separate process from FDCC application)
- While it eliminates the standard boarding fees for each entry, **you will still be responsible for processing fees, passenger taxes, tourism enhancement levies, and any other applicable taxes.**

Do I have to register for Click2Clear to apply for a Cruising Permit?

- **Only if you are applying for the 2 Year FDCC.**
- **If you are coming in for 12 months or less**, no registration is required. **No username or password is required.** Use the free login button beneath the username and password fields that states 'Request Cruising Permit' (yellow button).

NOTE: It is still essential to conduct a check-in each time to ensure that every vessel is documented. In-person approval for the Inbound Declaration remains necessary to legalize your entry.
